Counseling Services – St. Augustine, St Mary's and St Elizabeth parishes have partnered with Catholic Charities to provide counseling service. Each week, a caring capable therapist comes to Augustine's to meet with individuals, couples, and families who request this service. Services are provided for a fee based on the individual's or family's ability to pay. The sliding fee ranges from \$0 to \$85 per session. The parish's financial contribution for the program assists in this low or no fee option. No one is turned away. Requests for services can be made directly to Catholic Charities by calling Ellen Ketchum at 315-362-7568. People choose counseling for many different reasons, but all come with the same hope...that tomorrow will be better

St Mary's will be offering weekly bereavement sessions on Tuesdays from 1-2 PM. These sessions will be held on January 27, February 3, 10, 24 and March 3. This group will provide a safe place for you to speak openly about your loss and the difficulties you may be facing. It's a chance to be heard and understood. You can attend once or as often as you feel necessary. It will be facilitated by Sr. Marcia, MSW counselor with significant experience in group therapy and working with grief and loss.
