

**Parking** - The area near the main entrance is a designated fire lane for drop off and pickup only. It must be maintained for emergency response vehicle access. Please **DO NOT** park alongside the sidewalk or small island of trees. Thank you.

**Counseling Services** – St. Augustine, St Mary's and St Elizabeth parishes have partnered with Catholic Charities to provide counseling service. Each week, a caring capable therapist comes to Augustine's to meet with individuals, couples, and families who request this service. Services are provided for a fee based on the individual's or family's ability to pay. The sliding fee ranges from \$0 to \$85 per session. The parish's financial contribution for the program assists in this low or no fee option. No one is turned away. Requests for services can be made to Catholic Charities by calling Ellen Ketchum at 315-362-7568.

**St Mary's** will be offering weekly bereavement sessions on Tuesdays from 1-2 PM. These sessions will be held on February 3, 10, 24 and March 3. This group will provide a safe place for you to speak openly about your loss and the difficulties you may be facing. It's a chance to be heard and understood. You can attend once or as often as you feel necessary. It will be facilitated by Sr. Marcia, MSW counselor with significant experience in group therapy and working with grief and loss.

**Inclement Weather Notification** - If Baldwinsville School District **Closes**, there will be **NO** daytime or evening activities at the parishes (ie Daily Mass, adoration, confession) - **If Baldwinsville School District is delayed**, there will be **NO** daily morning mass. On Tuesdays, adoration will begin at noon, and Tuesday Novena Mass will still be held. **If Baldwinsville School District Cancels afternoon and evening activities**, **All** afternoon and evening activities (including Tuesday Novena Mass) will be cancelled. Meetings may be held via Zoom, this will be communicated by group leaders. All of this will be communicated through the parish social media accounts, at their earliest ability.
