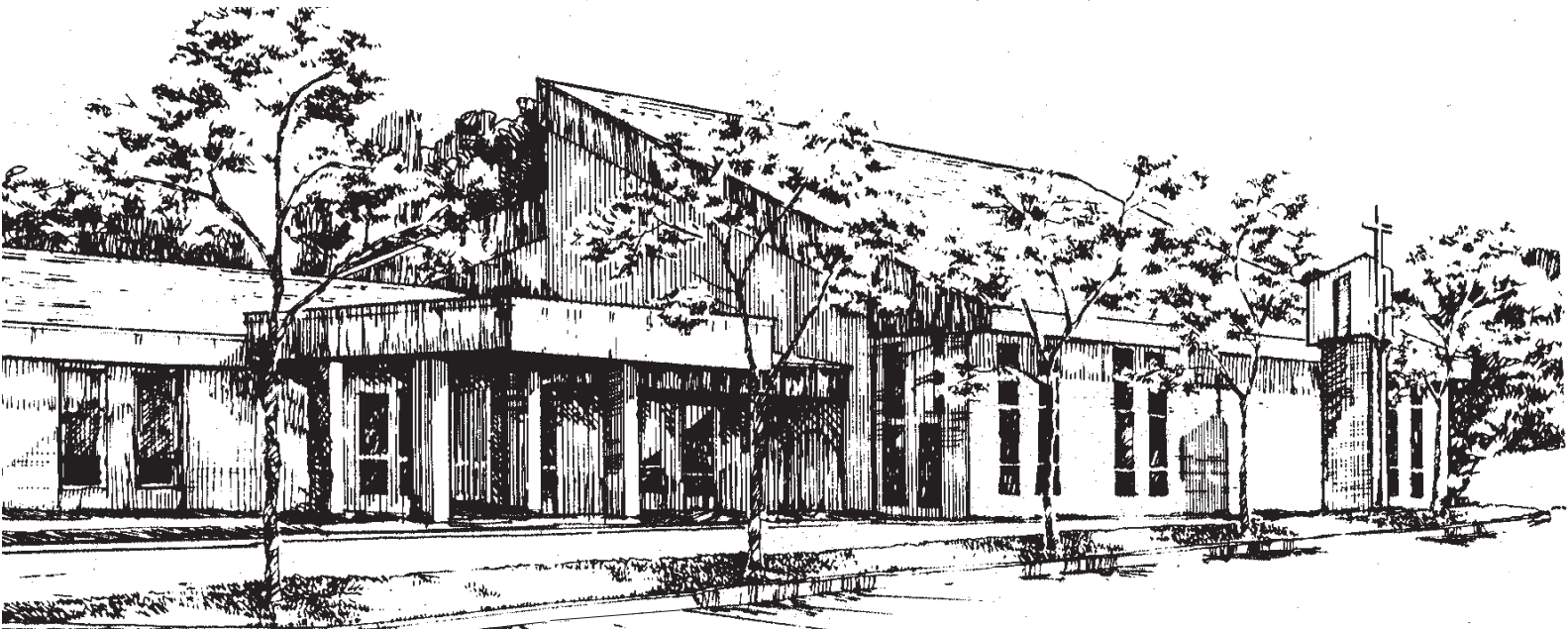

By taking a day of rest from labor to celebrate labor’s achievements, we are following in the footsteps of the Creator. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us: “God’s action is the model for human action. If God “rested and was refreshed” on the seventh day, man too ought to “rest” and should let others, especially the poor, “be refreshed.” The Sabbath brings everyday work to a halt and provides a respite. It is a day of protest against the servitude of work and the worship of money.” (CCC no. 2172). Let this reminder challenge your Sunday habits. How can you better honor the Lord’s day?
