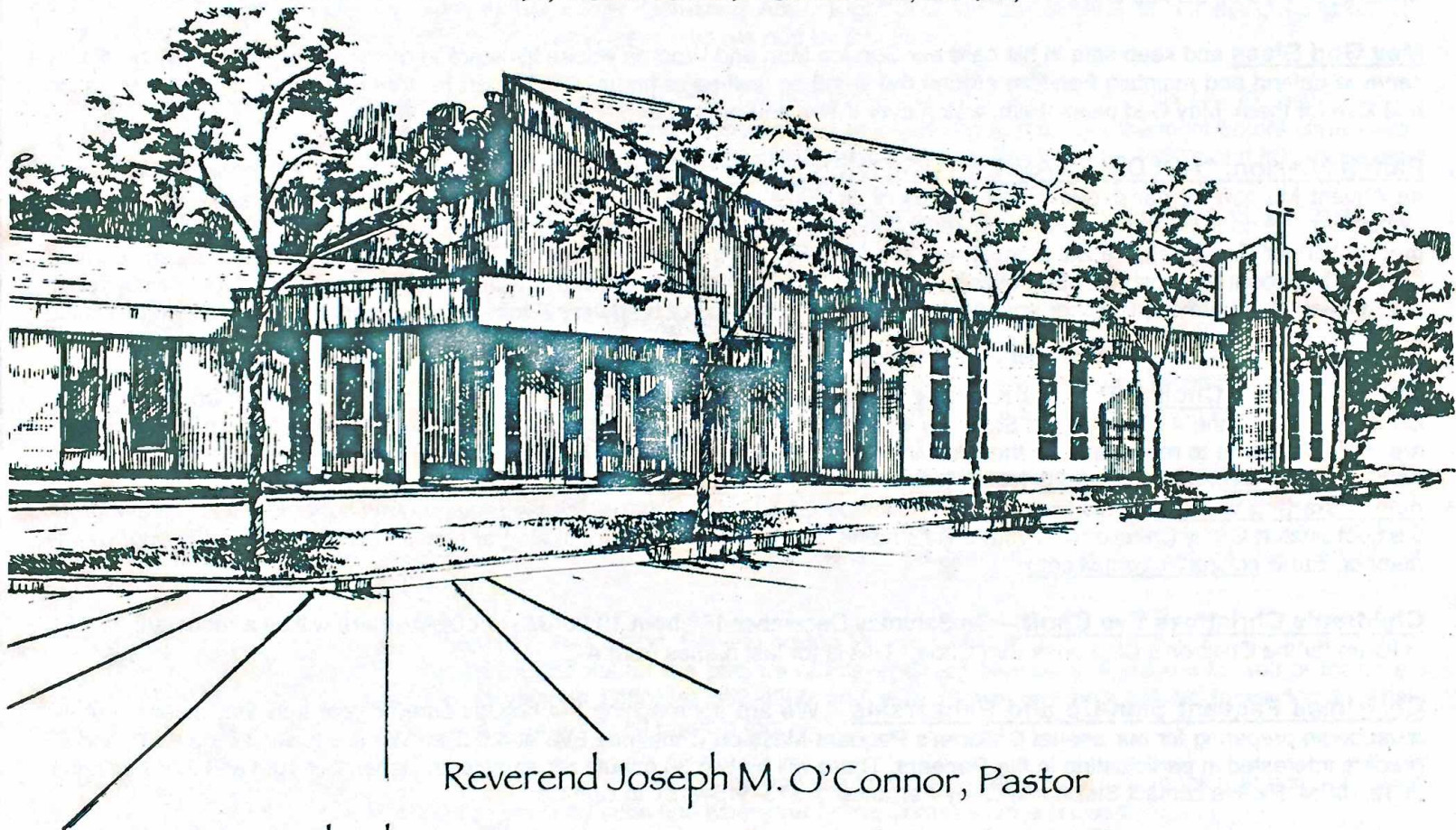

In addition to the usual schedule, Saturdays at 4:00PM, Confession will be available on the Wednesday nights of Advent (Dec 6, 13,20) from 6:00PM – 7:00PM. Also, Confession will be available at the Parish Mission Tal on Monday, December 4th. It is our hope that these expanded offerings will allow you to prepare to welcome the Birth of our Savior.

College Care Packages – We are gearing up to show our college students a sign of our love and support. We will be mailing them care packages with food and snacks and a few prayer cards to help them prepare for finals. Anna Asks....*How long should we fast before communion?* Since the 3rd century, Church writings call for fasting before receiving communion. For centuries, Christians fasted from food and water beginning at midnight the night before communion. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton writes about how difficult this was for her when she was sick. Through the 1950's and 60's there were adaptations made for medicine and water, and in 1983, the new Code of Canon Law gave us the law that is still in effect today: "One who is to receive the Most Holy Eucharist is to abstain from any food or drink, with the exception only of water and medicine, for at least the period of one hour before Holy Communion." The practice of fasting creates a physical hunger which is a great reminder of our spiritual hunger for Jesus, the Bread of Life.

Is This Mass Intention For Your Loved One? It is always a special moment for our parish whenever family members attend a Mass whose intention is for a deceased family member or loved one. In order to add to your celebration of the Mass we invite you to please inform any member of the hospitality team of your presence so you may be offered the opportunity to bring up the gifts during the offertory. This is a wonderful time for the entire community of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton church to join you in offering their prayers for you and for the person for whom this Mass is intended.
