Sportsmanship and Respect are very important to the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton program. They are a part of the basic philosophy at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. Please be reminded that we will play within the rules (no underhanded play or intentional fouls) and we will not be "talking trash" or verbally harassing the other team (at any time). Any St. Elizabeth Ann Seton player engaging in this type of behavior will be immediately removed from the game. This is how our teams are going to be run, regardless of what other coaches may have previously taught you. When you suspend your morals, play dirty, or bend the rules to win then you really haven't won at all. The lessons we learn at the other end of the building during mass do not disappear when we enter the gym. That doesn't mean that you should not play tough defense or good aggressive basketball. You certainly can (and should) -but within the bounds of the rules and within the bounds of fair play. If you have any problems (getting fouled, etc.) during the game you will not respond on the court, rather you should let your coach respond. If any parents have concerns they should let the coaches know as well. No refereeing from the bench or the stands.

Respect at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton is just as important. All Seton Staff shall be addressed as Coach, Mr. or Mrs. At no time will you argue or disrespect any Seton Staff member or you will be dismissed from the program.

Belief in and adherence to these two Seton philosophies are the reason that our program is recognized as one of if not the best in the CYO organization.
