Anna Asks... How many feast days in the Church are birthdays? This weekend, we celebrate the Birthday of St. John the Baptist. His mother, Elizabeth, was a cousin of Jesus' mother, Mary. When John was still in his mother's womb, he "leaped at the sound of Mary's voice." He knew whose presence he was in and he revered that. His birth was such a special moment in preparing the way for Jesus, that we celebrate his birthday with today's special feast day. That is not common. Most other feast days of saints are celebrated on the day which they died. There are only two other birthdays marked by feast days – can you guess them? What days are these birthdays? The answers are later in this bulletin.
